

5.0 Responsibility for Costs of Interconnecting a Facility

5.1 Review and Study Costs

The Interconnecting Customer shall be responsible for the reasonably incurred costs of the review by the PMLD and any interconnection studies and engineering reviews conducted to determine the requirements of interconnecting a Facility with the PMLD EPS.

5.2 Interconnection Equipment Costs

The Interconnecting Customer shall be responsible for all costs associated with the installation and construction of the Facility and associated interconnection equipment on the Interconnecting Customer's side of the PCC.

5.3 System Modification Costs

The Interconnecting Customer shall also be responsible for all costs reasonably incurred by PMLD attributable to the proposed interconnection project in designing, engineering, constructing, operating and maintaining the System Modifications.

5.4 Separation of Costs

Should the PMLD combine the installation of System Modifications with additions to the PMLD's EPS to serve other customers or interconnecting customers, the PMLD shall not include the costs of such separate or incremental facilities in the amounts billed to the Interconnecting Customer for the System Modifications required.
