Schedule a no-cost, no-obligation consultation with an independent heat pump expert to learn how the technology works, understand how heat pumps can reduce your heating costs, and receive guidance on using heat pumps for supplementary or whole-home heating. If a customer decides to purchase a heat pump, they will be guided through every step of the process from choosing a contractor, scheduling a post-installation inspection, and applying for a rebate from PMLD.

WHAT IS A HEAT PUMP?

- Provides heating and cooling in one system
- Takes existing heat and moves it through the home
- ✓ Very efficient heat source
- Can deliver one-and-a-half to three times more heat energy than the electrical energy it consumes

COST AND ENERGY SAVINGS

Heat pumps are a clean, efficient heating and cooling source. On average, heat pumps produce 3.5x less greenhouse gas emissions than oil, 3x less than propane, 2.8x less than natural gas, and 2.7x less than baseboard heating. PMLD customers who use heat pumps can save an average of \$1,400 to \$4,600 annually on their heating bills over oil, propane, and electric baseboard heating. PMLD customers may also be eligible for a heat pump rebate of \$625-\$1,750!
